Who can apply?

- Designed for practising or aspiring managers
- Ideally individuals will have the knowledge, skills and behaviours to drive business activities in a senior management and leadership role

Requirements

To gain this qualification you must be able to:

- Attend 3 full days (18 hours) of classroom based guided learning
- Complete 52 informal learning hours taken as study leave
- Complete 2 written assessment tasks of approximately 2000 words each
- Be able to embed any learning in a practical way within your Trust
- Take part in evaluation by providing feedback on your experience
